



Kois Study Group - Guidelines

1. If you are a Recognized Specialist, Graduate, Mentor or Clinical Instructor at the KoIs Center you are authorized to organize a KoIs Study Group
2. The Study Group organizer (or “Director”) must maintain active involvement in the KoIs Center to ensure currentness and consistency with the KoIs Center curriculum. At a minimum, the Director must attend the Annual KoIs Center Symposium every three out of five years.
3. Every member of the Study Group is required to have attended at least one KoIs Course at the KoIs Center in Seattle, Washington.

A *Kois Study Group Logo* is available for use and can be accessed by Recognized Specialists, Graduates, Mentors and Clinical Instructions through the “My Profile” page on the KoIs Center website.

If the Study Group composition changes so that the Study Group does to not meet the criteria above then the Study Group shall immediately cease using the KoIs Study Group title and/or Logo in any manner.
